ARTISTS MUST BE PRESENT TO SELL: Artists must be present to sell their Art. Youth Artists are not required to be at the booth for the entire show but must commit to the times filled in below (see "COMMITTED TIME"). The committee has the right to remove from the show any exhibitor not abiding by the rules without a refund. It also has the right to exclude any exhibitor to limit the number of entries in any category or who is not consistent with the rules. The Youth Booth will be supervised by an adult. Parent volunteers are encouraged. Volunteers must be registered with the Armory Youth Project (AYP). Please contact AYP to sign up as a volunteer.

YOUTH BOOTH ORIENTATION: All students must attend an orientation. Orientation will cover sales, booth rules, and requirements. Registered Volunteer Parents are welcome to join.
